## Crochet Pattern

### Type

🌸 Decoration

### Difficulty Level

🌸 Beginner

### Estimated Time

🌸 1.5 hrs - 2 hrs

🌸 4.5" x 4.5"

### Tools

🌸 Hook Size: 3.0

🌸 Yarn Needle

🌸 Scissors

### Materials

🌸 Yarn

🌸 Wire

🌸 Fiberfill

🌸 Bamboo stick



### Stitch abbreviations / guide

R#	round/row number
ch	chain
sc	single crochet stitch
sl st	slip stitch
BLO	work on back loop only
hdc	Half Doble Crochet
dc	Doble Crochet
tr	Treble Crochet





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### Let's Do it!

## Flower

Make 1

R1	Tulip color ch 19 turn your work	[19]
R2	Skip 1, 18sc , turn your work	[18]
R3	BLO 18 sc on each stitch, turn your work	[18]
R4-30	Keep going till you 6.5"	[18]
	Fasten off and cut yarn (long)	



## Leaf

Make 1

R1	Green color ch 30 turn your work	[30]
R2	3sc, 3hdc, 3dc, 11tr, 3dc, 3 hdc, 3sc	[29]
R3	Add wire with sl st and working on the other side of the ch 3sc, 3hdc, 3dc, 11tr, 3dc, 3hdc, 3sc. Secure the wire with a sl st	[29]
	Fasten off and cut yarn (not so long)	





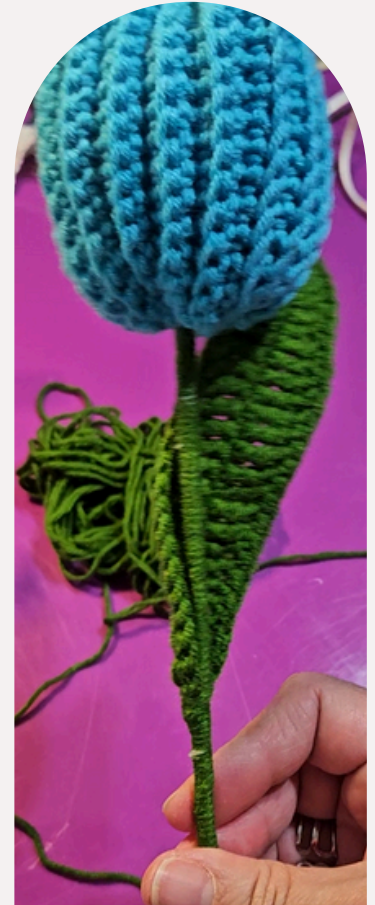


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## Crochet Pattern

### Assemble

- 1 Close the bottom making sure you have space to get the bamboo stick in
- 2 Insert the bamboo through the center
- 3 Use hot melt or liquid adhesive to secure the bamboo stick with the tulip
- 4 Insert fiberfill and fold the tulip closing at the top
- 5 Weave in loose yarn ends, and trim excess yarn
- 6 Wrap the stick with green yarn and secure it with hot melt or liquid adhesive, in your down attach the leaf
- 7 Make sure the leaf is touching the tulip for a more natural look.



**Tip for a perfect finish:**  
Insert the excess wire of the leaf while wrapping the stem with green yarn to cover it and secure the end of the stem with hot melt adhesive.
